HALL OF FAME – CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES

In consideration of nominations for the Baseball NL Hall of Fame, please note the following criteria must be met for all possible nominees:

- All nominees shall be 35 years of age or older and retired from active competition at all levels for a minimum three (3) years before being nominated
- Players, Coaches, Officials, Builders, and teams are eligible for nomination. Teams will only be considered in extraordinary circumstances.
- Emphasis for nominees shall be on Provincial, Atlantic, National and International competitions and experiences. This experience can include but is not limited to the following
 - o Players, Coaches, Officials and Teams (where applicable)
 - Personal and/or team success as a participant in Minor Provincial Championships;
 - Personal and/or team success as a participant in Junior Provincial Championships;
 - Personal and/or team success as a participant in Senior Provincial Championships;
 - Personal and/or team success as a participant in Atlantic Championships;
 - Personal and/or team success as a participant in National Championships;
 - Personal and/or team success as a participant in International events (either individually or as a member of Baseball Canada's National Team).
 - o Builders
 - Personal successes in any of the noted areas highlighted above;
 - Impact on baseball community at the Provincial, Atlantic, National and/or International level.
- Local league play may be considered but shall be a lesser component of the nomination. That component is for local association halls of fame.
- Nominations shall be well researched and documented. Simply saying that a player hit well or pitched well, etc. is not acceptable.
- A prospective nominee should be contacted in order to obtain additional career information.

When submitting a nomination, the selection committee will only consider the information provided on the nominee and will not be responsible to look for additional or supporting information. The onus remains on the nominator to put together a comprehensive and detailed case for a nominee's induction to the Baseball NL Hall of Fame. The submitted nomination will be what is considered.

Nominations for the Hall of Fame can be sent to the Baseball NL Office (baseballnl@sportnl.ca) by the submission deadline (which will be set annually by the Selection Committee and/or Baseball NL Office and communicated to local associations, membership and via Baseball NL website and social media platforms).

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
